## Squadron Leadership School

Squadron Leadership School (SLS) provides CAP's adult members with a basic understanding of CAP operations at the squadron level and how those operations affect CAP's national missions.

Additionally, members learn more about CAP customs, core values, and communications. Case studies, discussion, and group assignments are integral facets of the SLS. Squadron Leadership Schools are administered at group or wing level and last from 12 to 16 classroom hours. Students completing SLS are awarded a certificate of completion and this training is noted on their permanent record.

**Objectives.** Upon completion of the school, members should be able to:

- (1) Understand the basic expectations associated with being a CAP member; commit to serving as a staff officer or NCO.
- (2) Develop an appreciation for the essential role squadrons play in CAP; acquire practical knowledge necessary for serving as a staff officer.
- (3) Comprehend the leadership attitudes and skills necessary for serving effectively as a squadron staff officer.
